## **Moderator & Speaker - Goldie Sayers**



**Goldie Sayers** broke the British junior javelin record in 2001 and hasn't looked back since. Just three years later she was the youngest female athlete to compete in an individual event at the Athens Olympics. She went on to represent Team GB at the Beijing and London Games and has also been a World and European Championship finalist.

Having originally been awarded fourth place at the Beijing 2008 Olympic Games, Goldie was subsequently awarded the bronze medal after the Russian athlete, Mariya Abakumova, tested positive for a doping offence. Some 11 years on, Goldie was awarded her rightful bronze medal on 20 July 2019 at the London Anniversary Games

Goldie is a 'local' girl. Born in Newmarket, she went to The King's School, Ely and played county hockey, netball and tennis and was a national under-11 table tennis champion. She is now a director of a property company and is on the speaker circuit at events like this one!





## Carter Jonas



This 48-acre mixed-use development, situated on the Postwick Hub interchange, was designed to complement the environmental and heritage assets in the area. It features a new state-of-the-art Gridserve forecourt with 36 electric vehicle charging points, a pioneering service station for electric vehicles, which encourages their use on the park and in surrounding areas. Occupiers include Jaguar Land Rover, Lidl, Norfolk Constabulary and Howdens.



Believed to be the only retail park to be built from scratch over the last 12 months in the UK, the scheme was 88 per cent let upon completion with 100 per cent projected by Q2 2022. Featuring the likes of B&Q, Aldi, and M&S as occupiers, to name but a few, whilst also helping the surrounding community with a £2.6 million investment.



Having achieved planning permission in 2017, the park has gone from strength to strength. Located on the A14, just 42 miles from Felixstowe, the UK's busiest container port, it has attracted a range of international occupiers. As the only allocated employment site in the town, it has permission for up to two million sq ft of space with more than 1.4 million sq ft of it transacted to date. The next phase of the park is currently under construction and has already been pre-let. Occupiers of the park include Belgian firm Weerts Group, Treatt, Hermes Parcelnet Ltd and Sketchers UK.

Nestled amongst houses on Newmarket Road, Cambridge, this smaller scheme is statistically very impressive. Utilising the benefit of an empty office during a period of working from home and, coupled with the end of a lease, a joint venture between RJB Trust and MNL Trust took the existing building and added a two-storey extension over its car park. The scheme took the existing floorplan and remodelled it completely, increasing the lettable floor area by 65 per cent without the need to acquire additional land. The scheme also blends nicely into its surroundings, a necessity in a conservation area.




